EFI's Compliance Commitment: Internal Controls

Privacy Program Governance

The privacy team at EFI implements our key privacy initiatives, such as data privacy certifications, data subject access requests, internal data protections, and integrating the privacy by design principles into our products. The team is cross functional and works closely with several partner teams across the company, such as, legal, security and product.

Training

Employees take part in our mandatory annual privacy and security training to access systems within EFI. System access is only granted to employees who have a specific need to access such systems. We have implemented role-based access to systems that store or access sensitive personal data. We strive to build a culture that values privacy and security.

Personal Data Access Requests

If users would like to access their personal data or make any personal data deletion, correction, or transfer request and are located within the US, they may be done via this form.

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International Data Transfers

When transferring data from the European Union, the European Economic Area, and United Kingdom (UK), EFI relies upon several legal mechanisms, such as Standard Contractual Clauses, contracts with our customers, and the EU's adequacy decisions about certain countries.

EFI complies with the EU-U.S. Data Privacy Framework, as well as the UK Extension to the EU-U.S. Data Privacy Framework, as set forth by the Department of Commerce regarding the processing of personal data transferred from the European Union, the European Economic Area, and the UK to the United States. EFI has certified to the U.S. Department of Commerce that it adheres to these Data Privacy Frameworks with respect to such data.

GDPR: The General Data Protection Regulation

The GDPR went into effect on May 25, 2018, and aimed to harmonize data protection laws across Europe, and bring them up to speed with the rise of technology. In addition, it aimed to give individuals more control over their personal data. Organizations that are established in the EU, as well as organizations that process personal data of EU data subjects are required to comply with the GDPR.

EFI's GDPR Efforts

Data Minimization

One of the core elements of the GDPR's Privacy by Design requirement is collecting the minimum amount of data needed to perform a service/request. This means building out frameworks and controls that are aligned with this principle. We work to embed Privacy by Design principles into new products and features.

Record Keeping

The GDPR increases the obligations for organizations to keep detailed records of systems and processing activities across the business. Our Privacy Team manages and audits our records of processing across the business.

Transparency

Enabling Users to have more control over their data is another key area of the GDPR. At EFI, we provide the mechanism to submit requests via our online form or by mail.
